Brief when applying via video or voice note

- Your name/name of company and where you're based
- How you describe yourself (e.g. age, gender and ethnicity)
- Your contact details

- Some highlights from your CV/work so far. If you are a recent graduate that's fine to include performance and choreography work from your course.
- Why you are applying to the scheme
- What you would like to do during your visit. How does it connect to our values (kind, inclusive, inspiring, passionate)? Which programming theme does it link to (Dancing in the Streets, Digital Dance, Children & their Grown Ups, A Centre of Excellence)?

- The dates you would like to visit in August
- If you need any access support and/or help with accommodation. If you need any other support from the PDSW team (e.g. advice on company/project development)
